1) Smoke alarms greater than 10 years old MUST be replaced

Garage (Attached)

- 2) Carbon Monoxide alarms greater than 7 yeard old MUST be replaced
- 3) Combination smoke and cabon monoxide alarms MUST have voice (talking) feature
- 4) Any battery operated alarm replaced after December 1st 2016 must have a life-time sealed battery
- 5) Carbon Monoxide alarms are required in all homes which have ANY fossil fuel burning equipment and/or an attached garage

6) All alarms must be approved by a 3rd party testing lab (i.e. UL or ETL stamp on back of alarm)
